New Business:

Certified Ratio Discussion

Paul Binette the accessor for the town of Livermore Falls spoke in regards to the ratio as to the accessed value of the homes verses the price to which the homes are selling for in the market and difference is where the Certified Ratio is created.

For the first time in 10 years, we are not at 100% and what this means is that we can not give 100% on the exemptions that are given to the Taxpayers in Livermore Falls but instead they will be getting 94%. Homestead exemption will be going from \$25,000.00 to \$23,500.00 And Veterans exemption will be going from \$6000.00 to \$5640.00. This will also affect the property and personal property taxes as we Still have to have the revenue for the town and therefor Paul is asking the board to agree to the 94%.

Jeff is asking for recommendations- Paul's reply is that the 94% is the best recommendation with follow up re-evaluations for the town which actually could take a few years as many other towns are requesting re-evaluations as well because all the towns are struggling with the same problems due to the volatility of the housing market these days.

3.Issue at the Foundry Rd.

Bill spoke to the selectmen about the culvert on the Foundry Rd that had to be replaced at a cost of \$9,824.00 which did not include the pipe which came from the highway department.

Bill has spoken to Scott at the water department because he believes The problem with the culvert happened when the water department Had to drive a 36inch pipe under the Railroad tracks thinking that That culvert was no longer in use. Bill has requested to the selectboard that this bill be covered by the water department and Not the highway budget.

First motion made by Jeff to have Water Department cover this bill Second motion made by Ernie VOTE: 5-0 in favor of having highway pay this bill.

3. Sewer Department Treatment "Appendix C Mark has stated the sewer committee has worked together to come Up with the portions for Jay/Livermore Falls, the new figures are Jay 52.7% and Livermore Falls 47.3% This year the ratio has been Jay 56.1% And Livermore Falls 43.9%. This number is figured from the flow meters at routes 4 & 133.

Amanda asked Mark about some concerns of his raise and how it Would affect Livermore Falls as his salary is shared between the Two towns, Mark will look into the shared superintendent's agreement and get back to the select board.

First motion by Jeff to table the vote until Mark gets the requested information from the superintendent's agreement Second motion by Ernie VOTE: 4-1 in agreement
