MEMBERS PRESENT: Guy Palmieri, Chairman, Veronica Pillsbury, Lorraine Barney, Christine Pelletier, and Nancy McManemon.

On a motion from N. McManemon and a second by L. Barney the minutes of the January 16, 2002 Planning Board meeting were approved. VOTE 5-0-0.

OTHER BUSINESS

1. The members reviewed the draft of the "Curfew Ordinance" that the Town Manager had asked for comments on. After consultation with Officer Tom Gould the Board voted, on a MOTION from N. McManemon and a second by L. Barney, that the following changes be made:

1. Section II. Definitions. Curfew Hours.
Replace 10:01 PM with 9:01 PM.
Replace 10:31 PM with 9:31 PM.
Replace 11(☺) PM with 10:01 PM.
Keep the additional hour on Friday and Saturday evenings.
2. Add new Section VIII. Repealed. This Ordinance shall supersede all previous curfew ordinances, which are hereby repealed from and after the effective date of adoption of this Ordinance.

VOTE 5-0-0.

2. The members reviewed the draft of the "Dog Ordinance" that the Town Manager had asked for comments on. After several questions were addressed by Officer Tom Gould, the Board determined that there were no recommendations to the Dog Ordinance.

The Planning Board would appreciate knowing from the Town Manager if any of these amendments will be incorporated into the final drafts because if they are not, then the members present would like the opportunity to present the comments at the 3/18/2002 public hearing.

3. After a review of the latest draft of the Site Plan Review Application, the Board, on a MOTION from C. Pelletier and a second by V. Pillsbury, approved the application. VOTE 5-0-0.

On a motion from N. McManemon and a second by L. Barney, the Board voted to adjourn at 8:02 P M.
