- B. **LIVERMORE FALLS** — The Planning Board will address Wayne Parker Jr.'s application for an adult bookstore at 54 Depot St. when it meets Wednesday at the town office. Selectmen approved a moratorium on accepting any new applications for adult-related businesses Tuesday and will present it to voters Aug. 16. If it is approved, the moratorium will be retroactive to Aug. 2, Chairman Ken Jacques said.
