Dear David:

As you may know, the Bus/Maintenance Building on Cedar Street across from the Middle School is being demolished due to ice damage in order to be replaced with funds from the insurance company.

The demolition should occur during the week of August 20, 2001. Richard Parker will be doing the new construction with Louis Chabot doing the wiring.

I believe that a building permit will be needed before the replacement construction begins in mid to late September although it is possible that a frost wall on the west side will be installed earlier.

Since this is a "like-for-like" replacement using the insurance company's term, I believe that MSAD 36 only needs to apply for a building permit without having to attend a Planning Board meeting(s) etc. The dimensions and roof pitch will all be the same. It will have vinyl siding rather than T-111, and the overhead door will be on the gable end rather than the side facing Cedar Street. Other than that, the building will be essentially the same.

David, do I get the building permit from you in order for Richard Parker to complete with the specifications or can I just get the application in the town office?
