

**2026-2027 Annual Town Meeting Warrant  
Town of Livermore Falls, Maine  
April 28, 2026**

To: Ibrahim Y. Haroon, a constable of the Town of Livermore Falls, in the County of Androscoggin, in the State of Maine:

**Greetings:**

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the voters of the Town of Livermore Falls in the County of Androscoggin, in the State of Maine, qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to meet at the Livermore Falls Town Office in said Town of Livermore Falls on Tuesday, the 28<sup>th</sup> of April, 2026, at 8:00 in the forenoon, then and there to act on the following articles to wit. For voting on Articles 2 through 23 by secret ballot, the polls will open at 8:00 o'clock in the forenoon and close at 8:00 o'clock in the evening.

**Article 1.** To choose a Moderator to preside at said meeting.

**Article 2.** To choose by secret ballot the following Town Officials:

- One Selectman/Assessor for a two-year term;
- One Selectman/Assessor for a three-year term;
- One RSU #73 School Board Director for a three-year term; and
- One RSU #73 School Board Director for a two-year term;
- One RSU #73 School Board Director for a one-year term.

**To vote by secret ballot on the following Referendum Questions:**

**Article 3.** To see if the Town will vote to fix the date when real and personal property tax payments become due and payable with the first payment being due on Thursday, October 1, 2026, and the second payment being due on Thursday, April 1, 2027; and to instruct the Tax Collector to charge interest at a rate of 7% per annum on the unpaid balance of taxes beginning October 23, 2026 and March 19, 2027, respectively.

**Article 4.** To see if the Town shall affix an interest rate of 7% to any biannual sewer assessment not paid within the due date as established on the annual billing.

**Article 5.** To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate from taxation and other sources the sum of \$516,992 for the ensuing year for General Government (Select Board, Committees, Administration, Elections, Treasurer, Assessing, Code Enforcement, General Assistance, Contingency, Legal).

**Article 6.** To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate from taxation and other sources \$1,259,453 for the ensuing year for Public Safety (Police Department, Fire Department, Health Officer, Hydrants, Ambulance Service, Street Lights, Animal Control).

**Article 7.** To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate from taxation and other sources \$830,460 for the ensuing year for Public Works (Public Works, Roads, Buildings and Grounds, Transfer Station).

**Article 8.** To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate from taxation and other sources \$984,200 for the ensuing year for Sewer Department (Sewer and Sewer Treatment).

**Article 9.** To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate from taxation and other sources \$219,157 for the ensuing year for Culture and Recreation (Library, Community/Parks, Summer Recreation, Town Clock).

**Article 10.** To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate from taxation and other sources \$847,929 for the ensuing year for Benefits (Insurances, Benefits).

**Article 11.** To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate from taxation and other sources \$348,320 for the ensuing year for Capital Projects.

**Article 12.** To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate from taxation and other sources \$413,447 for the ensuing year for Debt Service.

**Article 13.** To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate from taxation and other sources \$13,500 for the ensuing year for Agencies (Cemeteries, Agency Requests)

**Article 14.** To see if the Town will vote to appropriate from the revenue of the Town's Tax Increment Financing District, the sum of \$8,000 for donation to the Jug Hill Riders.

**Article 15.** To see if the Town will vote to appropriate all Revenues received that are not dedicated or otherwise appropriated for other purposes for other expenses to reduce the tax commitment. Estimated revenues \$2,403,963.

**Article 16.** To see if the Town will vote to accept and appropriate estimated revenues in the sum of \$1,066,211 from State and Federal Revenue sources to reduce the property tax commitment.

**Article 17.** To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Select Board to carry forward any Unexpended Account Balance as they deem advisable and to authorize the Select Board to set at a later date the amount of such Surplus, if any, to reduce the tax commitment.

**Article 18.** To see if the Town will vote to authorize property tax abatements to be approved by the Select Board/Assessors from the property tax overlay or, if necessary, Unassigned Fund Balance.

**Article 19.** To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Select Board to retain, sell, or dispose of any real estate acquired by the Town for non-payment of sewer assessments thereon, for such terms as they may deem advisable and in the Town's best interest, and to execute quitclaim deeds for such property.

**Article 20.** To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Select Board to dispose of tax-acquired property as they deem in the best interest of the Town, pursuant to the process set forth in 36 M.R.S.A. §943-C.

**Article 21.** To see if the Town will vote to, in accordance with 36 M.R.S.A. §506, to authorize the Tax Collector and Town Treasurer to accept prepayment of taxes not yet committed and pay no interest thereon.

**Article 22.** To see if the Town of Livermore Falls (P0109) will vote to change its plan for its eligible general government employees effective July 1, 2026 for future service only.

The Town agrees:

- a) To provide Regular Plan AC to its general government employees who regularly work more than 20 hours per week who are not seasonal or temporary for service rendered after June 30, 2026. Service accrued by general government employees before July 1, 2026 remains under Regular Plan AN; and
- b) To continue to provide Special Plan 1C to its police officers who regularly work more than 20 hours per week who are not seasonal or temporary; and
- c) To continue to exclude all other employees, including those who regularly work 20 hours per week or less, seasonal employees, temporary employees and elected officials from participating in The Plan; and
- d) To authorize the Town Manager to sign the Amended Agreement between the Town and the Maine Public Employees Retirement System.

**Article 23.** Shall an ordinance entitled “Town of Livermore Falls Cannabis Ordinance” as revised March 2026, be enacted?

**The Select Board hereby give notice that the Registrar of Voters will be at the Town Office on \_\_\_\_\_ for the purpose of accepting registrations and correcting the voting list.**

A person who is not registered to vote may not vote in any election.
